

Climate Counsellor Guide



Apply: Fill the Climate Counsellor's Application form on our Website and choose a slot for the Interview call.



Interview: You'll receive a call from us for a Telephonic Interview. If selected, you'll receive a Selection email from ICCE with your username & password to access the My Account Page along with a Survey link (refer Data Generation Activity).



Login to My Account: On My Account Page, you will find all the required documents and e-posters for promotions & registration.



Spread the Word: As a Climate Counsellor your key role is to spread awareness about Green (R)evolution and get participants registered for the program. You can also make use of our e-posters and write-ups for online promotions.



Data Generation Activity: The initial step for you as a Climate Counsellor is to generate data. For this activity, a survey link will be shared with you through your Selection email. You need to share this link among your network. The Data of Interested leads will be emailed to you, so you can contact and guide them for the registration of Green (R)evolution program.



Register Participants: Collect Registration fees and mandatory details of the participants as mentioned in the Registration form.



Advanced Program: An Advanced Online Program on Global Warming is available exclusively for those who have completed Green (R)evolution Basic Certification Program. The Registration fee is Rs. 650/- and Rs. 100/- needs to be kept with the Climate Counsellor as rebate.



Your Rebate: You receive a rebate of Rs. 50/- per registration (i.e approx. 6.5% per registration) for 24 registrations. On submission of more than 24 registrations, the rebate would be doubled to Rs. 100/- per registration (i.e approx. 13% per registration). The rebate amount can be retained by you or used for administrative purposes.



Distribute Material: Once the Registration form and fee is submitted; Green (R)evolution Global Program Books and CDs will be dispatched & delivered within 10 working days by courier. Consignment details will be mailed to you.



Plant-a-seed: As a part of compulsory activity, all the basic program participants will have to promote the plant-able pencils for Rs. 25/- each and use the leaflet along with it to explain the issue of Climate Change and the steps one has to take to prevent it. Participants have to ask the buyers of the pencils to give a miss call on the number mentioned on the leaflet to support the cause (An email will be sent to them regarding the Plant-a-Seed Competition). The fund collected by the participants after performing the activity has to be submitted to ICCE. The Funds are used for Social Activities. If Pencils are not promoted it has to be returned to ICCE for dispatch of the certificates. Extra grades are provided for the promotions of extra pencils.



Wear-a-Change: As a part of compulsory activity, all the advance program participants will have to promote the seed-paper wristbands for Rs. 15/- each and use the leaflet along with it to explain the issue of Global Warming and the steps one has to take to prevent it. Participants have to ask the buyers of the wristbands to give a miss call on the number mentioned on the leaflet to support the cause. The fund collected by the participants after performing the activity has to be submitted to ICCE. The Funds are used for Social Activities. If Wristbands are not promoted it has to be returned to ICCE for dispatch of the certificates. Extra grades are provided for the promotions of extra wristbands.



Exams: Assessment will be through Online or Offline exam per group. Descriptive / Scenario Questions will be asked with No Right or Wrong Answers. Grades A+, A and B will be awarded. Similarly credits will be provided for the Plant-a-seed/Wear-a-Change activity.



Certificates: Green (R)evolution Program Certificates, Medallions etc. will be sent to the Climate Counsellor. Advance Course Participants will receive an Advanced Certificate and won't be eligible for College Topper nominations.
